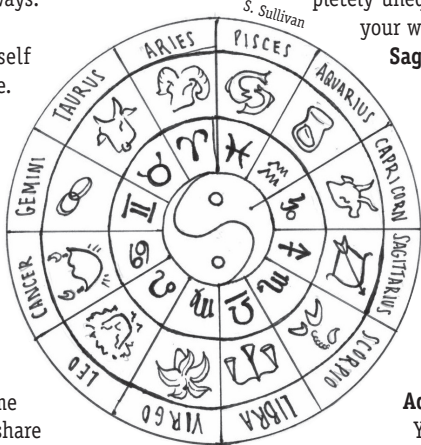

- 11. Bring Your Kid to School Day** – this one wasn't thought through...

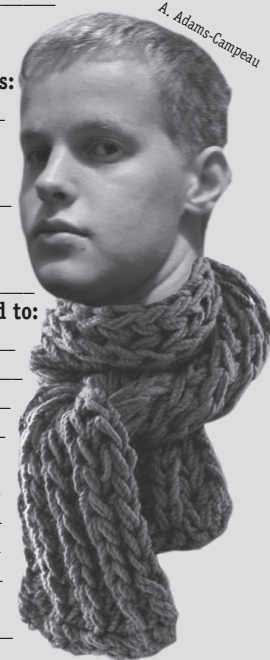
